General Uniform Guidelines

- Coats and hats are not permitted inside the school building.
- All pupils must bring their blazer to school every day.
- Pupils who do not adhere to the uniform expectations will receive appropriate sanctions.
- Trainers are not permitted; all pupils must wear formal school shoes.
- If you require financial assistance with uniform, please contact the school office for support.

PE Kit Expectations (Year 7 & Year 8)

- Pupils must wear the official HHA PE kit on their allocated PE days.
- Leggings and branded tracksuit bottoms are not allowed; only plain black tracksuit bottoms are permitted.
- Pupils must also bring their blazer on PE days.
- Any pupil arriving in incorrect PE or school uniform will be sent home to change.

Additional Reminders

- Baseball caps are not allowed and will be confiscated if worn.
- Pupils are expected to dress smartly and act smartly at all times.

We appreciate your support in maintaining our high standards. Should you have any concerns or require assistance with uniform, please do not hesitate to contact the school office so that your child is appropriately dressed for the term starting after the Easter holiday.
